MEMORANDUM:

TO: The President

FROM: Walter

Abe has talked with Katzenbach and Katzenbach has talked with the Attorney General. They recommend a seven man commission - two Senators, two Congressmen, the Chief Justice, Allen Dulles, and a retired Military Man (General or Admiral.) Katzenbach is preparing a description of how the Commission would function. Abe needs quickly the following answers:

(1) Is the composition of the Commission outlined above satisfactory?

(2) Could you talk to Eastland and the appropriate Member on the House side (Celler), Boggs, or whoever - and tell them what you are doing.

(3) Is it agreeable for Abe and Katzenbach to talk to the Chief Justice and feel him out?
