to - uh - appear before them or - either that or -umbe taken to Washington before the full Commission, uh -I was cooperating by telling them what I knew and - uh not attempting to - uh - be difficult in any manner but along simply to go/with the questions that they were asking. When he -uh- changed the subject, well, I had no choice but to answer his questions.

Q. Where would you say the search was concentrated after the shots were fired?

A. The first focus of interest certainly was the embankment which - uh - lies uh - directly to the South and -uh slightly to the East of the Triple Underpass . I mean this motorcycle policeman I previously mentioned certainly -uh was going there just as rapidly as possible. Ah - as I saw the - uh - motorcade , after disappearing under the Triple Underpass, make their turn and then gain considerable speed -uh- going out toward Parkland - uh - there was a large concentration of police officers-uh-into this area here at the top of the embankment. Now I could see back or the South side of the wooden fence in the area, so that obviously that there was no one there who could have-uh had anything to do with either - as accomplice or anything else because there was no one there...um... at the moment this that the shots were fired. Immediately following (secondary) there was a rapid surge of people coming up the embankment from across Elm Street, from over near Houston Street
